Not available for public viewing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Documents containing personal data which cannot be disclosed because of a lack of legal basis;</li> <li>• confidential documents;</li> <li>• documents requiring third-party consent for disclosure and where relevant consent for publication has not been given;</li> <li>• commercially sensitive documents where publication of the information or document could have an adverse effect on the organisation; and</li> <li>• documents which attract legal professional privilege.</li> </ul>
