What should I include?

We want to hear more about the human impacts of the scandal from anyone impacted. This could be current or former sub-postmasters, current or previous employees or associates of one of the organisations linked to the scandal (for example Post Office Limited, Fujitsu, government departments), family members, friends, community members, or general members of the public who have been impacted by the scandal.

What you share in relation to impacts can be:

- Impacts on mental health
- · Impacts on physical health
- · Impacts on family and friends
- Impacts on communities
- Impacts on employment prospects or employment journeys
- · Impact on business opportunities
- Impact on housing
- Impacts on education
- Impacts on other relationships
- · Impacts on quality of life

It is important to note that this form is not about providing evidence on any matters covered in public hearings, but about the human impact of the scandal.

Messages that are offensive or which incite harm and/or violence will not be accepted in 'In Your Own Words'.
