With apologies for the delay, I attach four advice notes received from Brian Altman QC:


1. "Interim Review of CK's Current Review Process" dated 2 August 2013, which advised on the approach being adopted to reviewing past prosecutions (in particular POL's duty of disclosure) following publication of Second Sight's July 2013 Report;
2. "General Review" dated 15 October 2013, which focussed on POL's past prosecution practices;
3. "Review of Post Office Ltd Prosecution Role" dated 31 October 2013, which made recommendations about how POL might prosecute going forward; and
4. "Advice on Suggested Approach to Criminal Case Mediation" dated 5 September 2014, which advised on Tony Hooper's suggested approaches to mediating criminal cases in the Scheme.
