GROUP LITIGATION – HORIZON ISSUES TRIAL

REACTIVE MEDIA LINES TO TAKE IF DISRUPTION TO NETWORK EG SOME BRANCHES REFUSE TO OPEN

- The vast majority of our 11,500 Post Office branches are open for business as usual.
- We are sorry that a small minority of branches are closed but we're doing all we can to work with those postmasters to re-open as soon as possible. Customers are advised to use other branches in the area [contact xxxx].
- Customers can continue to have confidence in Post Office products and services.
 Around 47 million transactions a week are processed through Post Office branches on behalf of other large-scale organisations including high street banks, utility companies and Government departments.
- The litigation is part of a long-running dispute between Post Office and a small proportion of mainly former postmasters.
- The case is complex and is being heard in stages, currently scheduled through t 2020.
 The Judgment concerning the Horizon computer system covered technical matters
 relating to the 20-year period spanned by individual claims, during which time there
 have been significant changes, with some of the systems and processes referenced
 no longer in existence.
